

Penn's Powell Fans 18 on Yale

PHILADELPHIA, April 27—Grover Powell struck out eighteen players today as he pitched Pennsylvania to an 8-3 victory over Yale. The triumph was the third in four Eastern Intercollegiate League baseball games for the Quakers.

Powell fanned four men in the third inning. A batter in this inning struck out, but reached first when the catcher dropped the ball. The left-hander then fanned the side. He also struck out three in the seventh and at least one man in every other inning.

With the score 3—3, Penn got four runs, two unearned, in the seventh inning.
