

PENN TURNS BACK

V. M. I. FIVE, 84-80

Wideman's 24 Points Lead
Victors—Buffalo Upsets
Villanova by 63-62

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 3 (UPI) — Pennsylvania's youthful basketball team built an early 18-point lead, then withstood a late Virginia Military Institute rally tonight for an 84-80 victory in the second game of a double-header at the Palestra.

In the opener, Buffalo upset Villanova, 63—62.

John Wideman, one of four sophomores in Penn's starting line-up, led the scoring with 24 points. Four of his goals came in the final three minutes after VMI had come within a point at 70—69.
