

Penn Sinks Rutgers, 81-60

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 9

(AP) — The Pennsylvania basketball team recovered from a first-half lapse and coasted to an 81-60 victory over Rutgers at the Palestra tonight.

The Quakers ran up an early 14-point lead but, sparked by Doug Patton, Rutgers took a 38-37 half-time edge.

Bob Purdy, with 23 points, and John Wideman, with 20, led Penn. Patton was high for Rutgers with 21.
