

PENN SETS BACK

YALE FIVE, 73-51

Purdy Scores 22 Points for Quakers—La Salle Wins From Manhattan, 74-68

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 13 (AP)—Pennsylvania recovered from a lapse in the opening minutes against Yale tonight and then coasted to a 73-51 basketball victory at the Palestra.

La Salle defeated Manhattan, 74-68, in the second game of the double-header. La Salle took a 10-0 lead at the start and Manhattan never caught up.

Penn's victory, its first in Ivy League play, broke a five-game losing streak. The defeat left Yale with a 2-1 Ivy record.

Pacing the Quaker attack was a sophomore, Bob Purdy, with 22 points. Bob Mlkvy added 19 and Dick Biborosch 15. Mlkvy, who scored only 11 points in his two previous games, sank four field goals in succession late in the first half.

After its quick opening attack, La Salle's lead steadily dwindled and, midway through the first half, the Jaspers tied the game, 22-22. By half-time, La Salle had regained the lead, 42-32.

With only 1 minute 47 seconds left, a lay-up by Ron Petro brought Manhattan to within 4 points of La Salle. But a brilliant fake and driving lay-up by Bob McAteer of La Salle, followed by free throws by McAteer and Tony Abbott decided the game.
