PRINCETON, N. J., Feb. 7—

Scoring on 54 per cent of its shots from the floor, the Princeton basketball team defeated Penn, 77—55, in an Ivy League contest before a crowd of 2,400 at Dillon Gymnasium tonight.

The league-leading Tigers recorded their fifth Ivy victory of the season without a loss. The defeat was Penn's third in five league starts. Princeton's over-all record now is 11—3.

Al Kaemmerlen led the Princeton scorers with 22 points. Don Swan, the Tiger captain, snared 13 rebounds.

In winning the Tigers extended their string of consecutive Ivy victories at home to eighteen.
