

## Amira Leads Quakers

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 17 (AP)—Pennsylvania took the lead at 4—3 and stayed ahead after that in defeating Cornell, 65—58, tonight before a crowd of 864 at the Palestra.

The defeat virtually eliminated the Big Red from Ivy League championship contention. Cornell's record now is 5—4.

Sid Amira, with 18 points, and Dick Biborosch, with 14, paced Penn. Gerry Krumbein led Cornell with 13 points.

Penn, scoring its ninth victory in eighteen starts, led by as many as 17 points during the first half. At intermission, the Quakers led, 41—26. Penn's biggest lead of the night came midway in the second half at 57—39.
