

Penn Beats Brown, 58-57

PROVIDENCE, R. I., Jan. 12 — Pennsylvania rallied to defeat Brown, 58—57, tonight in an Ivy League basketball game.

Gene Barth, Gary Nell and Captain Mike Cingiser of Brown paced the attack that overtook the Quakers early in the second half. Brown led, 47—41, midway in the period.

The Quakers got back in the running on scores by Dick Biborosch and Jeff Sturm and finally went ahead, 51—50, with five minutes to play.

Brown missed two chances to score the winning basket in the final seconds.

It was Penn's second straight Ivy victory and its seventh in ten games. Brown suffered its third straight Ivy defeat and its ninth in twelve games.
