ITHACA, N. Y., Feb. 24—Cornell's basketball team rebounded from last night's loss to Yale and defeated Brown, 66—62, in an Ivy League game tonight.

By beating Brown, the Big Red solidified its hold on second place in the league's standing. Cornell now has a 9-3 won-lost record against Ivy competition.

In its last home appearance of the season, Cornell trailed in the early stages as Mike Cingiser, Brown's jump-shooting left-hander, scored 20 points in the first half. Brown led, 40—38, at half-time.

Cingiser, who went scoreless for the first eleven minutes of the second half, finished as the game's high scorer with 24. A team-mate, Gene Barth, tallied 21.
