

HARVARD DEFEATS BROWN IN SOCCER

1-0 Victory Sets Up Possible Tie for Ivy League Title

PROVIDENCE, R. I., Nov. 16—Harvard handed Brown its first soccer defeat of the season today and moved into position to tie the Bruins for the Ivy League championships.

Chris Chiri, Harvard's Olympic star from Nigeria scored at 10:59 of the fourth period when he headed in a corner kick by Morgan Hudson. That was enough to give Harvard a 1-0 victory.
