

PENN BEATEN, 87-75, BY MICHIGAN STATE

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 14 (AP)—Pete Gent of Michigan State scored 28 points and led the Spartans to an 87—75 triumph over Penn in the second game of tonight's Palestra double-header before 4,481 fans.

It was Penn's first defeat in four games and the Spartans's fourth victory in a row.

In the opener Temple, using crushed American University 83—54.

Michigan State, which had scored more than 100 points in each of its first three games erased a 16—12 Penn edge early in the first half. The Spartans were never threatened until the last seven minutes when the Quakers pulled to within, 70—67, mainly on the shooting of Ray Carazo and John Hellings.
