

**Penn Defeats Brown**

PROVIDENCE, R. I., Feb. 21  
— Penn remained tied with Princeton for first place in the Ivy league tonight by defeating Brown, 83-63. The Quakers led from the start in scoring their fifth straight victory. They raised their season record to 12—8 and their Ivy mark to 8—2.

Penn's tight man-to-man defense restricted the Bruins' ball-handling and shooting. The Quakers, meanwhile, made 37 of 75 field goal attempts.
