Shaw Holds Losers to Six Hits in Ivy League Game

PHILADELPHIA, April 17—Jim Shaw, a sophomore left-hander, held Penn to five singles and a double today as Dartmouth won, 7-2, in an Eastern Intercollegiate League baseball game on Stewart Field.

Ken McCruthers led the Dartmouth attack with three hits. The victors got four runs in the first inning on five hits, three Penn errors and a hit batsman.

Jeff Neumann, Penn's starting pitcher, picked off three Dartmouth men and had four assists as he pitched eight innings.
