

Dartmouth Downs Penn

PHILADELPHIA, April 24—Dartmouth, the defending co-champion with Harvard and Princeton, won its opening lacrosse game in the Ivy League today. The Indians toppled Pennsylvania, 10-6, before 1,500 spectators.

Penn, previously undefeated, with victories over Harvard, Brown and Yale, led by 5-3, in the second quarter. Dartmouth then scored five straight goals. Joe Cohon, with four goals, paced the winners.
