

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 4
 (AP)—Penn's senior backcourt duo of Stan Pawlak and Jeff Neuman totaled 45 points between them tonight as Penn defeated Navy, 72-55, at the Palestra.

In the second game of the double-header, Temple defeated Delaware, 85-63.

In the opener Pawlak scored 25 points on 11 field goals and three free throws, while Neuman tallied 20 and contributed nine assists. They helped Penn gain its second victory of the season as Navy suffered its second loss without a triumph.

Navy came out in a zone defense in the second half, slowing the pace considerably and enabling the middies several times to cut the lead to 10 points. But Neuman and Pawlak, shooting from outside of the Navy zone, kept Penn well ahead as the two scored 15 of 18 points in a streak midway through the final half.

Jim Snook, with 16 points and Chris Reddington, with 13, led Navy.
