

Princeton Routs Penn Six With Early Barrage, 7-0

PRINCETON, N.J., Jan. 27—Princeton scored five times in the opening period and coasted to a 7-0 victory over the University of Pennsylvania in a hockey game at Baker Rink tonight.

The Tiger goalie, Regan Kerney, needed only 16 saves for his shutout, while Lloyd Smith of Penn had 56 saves.

Terry Peterman and Jerry Kearney scored two goals apiece for Princeton, which now has a 14-0 advantage in the series. Princeton has a 3-7 won-lost record this season and Pennsylvania has an 8-9 mark.
