

R.P.I. Routs Penn, 18-2, In Opening Hockey Game

TROY, N. Y., Nov. 25—Dale Watson, a junior, and Chuck Rancourt and John Renwick, sophomores, each scored three goals as Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute registered an 18-2 victory over the University of Pennsylvania in the opening hockey game of the season for both teams.

Watson, who led the nation in scoring with 65 points during regular season play last year, recorded five points on three goals and two assists before a crowd of 3,500. Barry Law, another forward, had 6 points on two goals and four assists.

A pair of RPI goalies made only 15 saves while two Penn goal-tenders stopped 49 shots.
