

PRINCETON WINS IN TRACK, HOCKEY

But Tigers Are Beaten by
Penn Wrestlers, 20-14

PRINCETON, N. J., Feb. 3—Princeton University captured two of three of its sports contests here today.

In track, the Tigers rallied to defeat Dartmouth, 62-46, at Lavino Field House. Dartmouth won four of five field events, but Princeton came back strong in the running events, sweeping all three places in the 60-yard and the 1,000-yard run, which were won by Herman Stevenson and Capt. Jack Endrikat, respectively.

Bill Schopf of Kennilworth, Ill., put the shot 51 feet 5 inches, breaking a school mark that had stood 15 years. Eamon Downey of Islip, L. I., set a Tiger record of 9:05.6 in the two-mile run.

In hockey, Princeton turned back Yale, 4-2. The Tigers never trailed, and outshot the Bulldogs, 36-14. Terry Peterman, a senior wing, scored the decisive goal at 12:44 of the third period.

Five minutes later, John Ritchie, a senior center, fired a pass to Mike Wiggins, a wing. Wiggins slapped the puck in from five feet out on the right to give the Tigers an insurance goal.

In wrestling, Pennsylvania downed Princeton, 20-14, giving the Quakers an inside track on the Ivy League title. Penn now has a 3-0 won-lost mark in league competition, having beaten Princeton, Harvard and Cornell, the three top finishers in the league last year.

Going into today's meet, both squads were undefeated, with Penn 5-0-1, and Princeton 4-0.
