

PRINCETON RALLY SINKS PENN, 59-56

Petrie Sparks Tigers in
Contest at Palestra

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 3 (AP) —Princeton, led by the second-half shooting of Jeff Petrie, rallied for a 59-56 victory over Penn tonight in the second game of a basketball double-header at the Palestra.

In the opener, Textile routed St. Michael's of Vermont, 91-53, as Paul Poole poured in 20 points.

Petrie scored 18 of the Tigers' last 18 points to bring the visitors from a 9-point deficit to victory.

His two foul shots with 1 minute 58 seconds remaining gave Princeton its first lead, 55-54, since early in the second half.
