Penn Upsets Villanova, 32-30, on Basket by Bilsky With 3 Seconds to Play

CAUTIOUS ATTACK WINS FOR QUAKERS

Penn Controls Ball for Last
3½ Minutes to Get Final
Shot Against Zone

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 15
(UPI) — Steve Bilsky's jump
shot with three seconds re-
maining gave Pennsylvania a
32-30 upset basketball victory
over Villanova tonight.

Temple defeated Pitt, 53-30,
in the first game of the double-
header at the Palestra.

Penn stressed ball control
throughout and held the ball
for the final three minutes and
35 seconds to get its final shot.
The Quakers played cautiously
and deliberately against Villa-
nova's tight zone defense, wait-
ing for the good shot. Their suc-
cess snapped Villanova's five-
game winning streak.

Villanova's Howard Porter,
who had averaged 23.3 points
a game, made only three and
his missed free throw gave the
ball to Penn for the final 3½
minutes. Bilsky was high man
with 10 points.
