CAMBRIDGE, Mass., Feb. 1— Pennsylvania, led by two sophomore guards, David Wohl and Steve Bilsky, with 22 and 18 points, respectively, gained a 75-70 victory over Harvard tonight in an Ivy League game.

Penn now has a 9-8 won-lost record and is 4-2 in the league. Harvard is 5-11 over all and 1-4 among the Ivies.
