

Quakers Take 10th

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 9— Pennsylvania, lifting its won-lost record to 10-1, took the lead for good four minutes from the end of the first half and went on to defeat Dartmouth's basketball team, 89-75, in an Ivy League game tonight before a slim Palestra crowd.

Penn, making its strongest league start since the 1954-55 season, has a 3-0 won-lost record in Ivy play while Dartmouth is 1-1 and 6-3 over all.

Dartmouth drew even four times in the opening half, the last time at 33-all with 4 minutes left. Penn advanced to 47-41 by half-time and increased its lead to 53-41 in the early minutes of the second half.
