Cambridge, Mass., Feb. 6 (AP)—John Koller came off the bench in the second half tonight, hit on six straight field-goal attempts and led Penn to an 86-77 basketball victory over Harvard. It was the Quakers' seventh triumph in Ivy League play in which they are unbeaten.

Koller's first four baskets virtually nailed down the triumph as Penn, beaten only once in 19 games, stretched its lead from 67-59 to 75-63.

Harvard made a strong bid for an upset. However, Penn, sparked by Dave Whol, gained a 45-39 half-time lead. Harvard closed to within 62-67 midway through the second half. Then Corky Calhoun tallied 5 straight points for Penn before Koller took charge.
