HANOVER, N. H., Feb. 7—

The University of Pennsylvania lived up to its national ranking as the Quakers romped to a 96-68 Ivy League basketball victory over Dartmouth before a crowd of 2,000 tonight in Alumni Gym.

Penn, with a 19-1 won-lost record and leading the Ivy League race with an 8-0 slate, broke away from the Indians midway in the first half and increased its lead with its sharpest shooting of the season. The Quakers sank 53 per cent from the floor in the first half as they gained a 49-34 lead.

Bob Morse and Corky Calhoun led Penn's attack, which shot a torrid 48 per cent from the floor. Morse scored 22 points, while Calhoun had 18. Steve Bilsky and Dave Wohl got 17 and 11, respectively.

The loss leaves Dartmouth with a 10-9 over-all record and a 4-4 mark in the Ivy League.
