

Cornell Sextet Tops Penn For 22d Straight, 7 to 3

ITHACA, N. Y., Feb. 28—Brian McCutcheon scored two of his three goals in the first minute of the third period today to lead the undefeated hockey team to a 7-3 victory over Penn. Cornell has a 22-0 won-lost record while Penn stands at 6-15. The victory was also Cornell's 32d straight in Ivy League competition.

The Quakers tied the game three times before McCutcheon's third-period outburst.

John Marks, the Penn goalie, finished with 60 saves as Cornell had 130 shots. Brian Cropper, Cornell's net-minder, had 14 saves.
