

PENN VANQUISHES LAFAYETTE, 31-20

Hoffman Standout in Opener of Twin Bill—Drexel Wins

PHILADELPHIA, Oct. 17 (UPI)—Bob Hoffman, a sophomore fullback, plunged for two touchdowns in the fourth quarter, the second with three minutes left, to lead Pennsylvania to a 31-20 victory over Lafayette today.

It was the first game of a double-header at Franklin Field, a rarity in college football. In the second game Drexel sprang an upset by toppling Lehigh, 6-0. The score came on a 40-yard run by Leslie Broglie in the second quarter.

Hoffman went over on runs of 2 and 4 yards. His second score put the Quakers ahead to stay, 24-20.

Penn led, 10-7, at the half, on a 32-yard field goal by Elliot Berry and a 4-yard run by Pancho Micir, while Bob Donofrio was scoring on a 14-yard run for Lafayette.

Donofrio gave Lafayette a 13-10 lead on a 30-yard dash in the third quarter, setting the stage for a frantic fourth quarter.

Hoffman scored to put Penn ahead, 17-13, but the Leopards bounced back on a 1-yard scoring run by Rich McKay for a 20-17 lead.

Hoffman added his winning tally and a reserve quarterback, Gary Shue, got an insurance touchdown on a 6-yard run.

Lafayette's Ed McCormick intercepted two passes.
