

# PENN OVERTAKES SYRACUSE, 85-77

## Bilsky Tallies 10 Points in Overtime—Utah, Temple and St. Joseph's Victors

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 26 — Steve Bilsky scored 10 points in an overtime period as Penn defeated Syracuse, 85-77, today in the first round of the 19th annual Quaker City college basketball tournament.

In the first game, Utah defeated Army, 65-56, as Eddie Trail and Mike Newlin combined for 33 points.

Mike Bantom, a 6-foot-8-inch sophomore, scored 32 points as he led St. Joseph's to a 100-83 victory over West Virginia in the opening night contest.

Penn, undefeated in six games and ranked sixth in the nation, had to rally in the second half before subduing a surprising Syracuse team, which led by as many as 5 points twice in the final 20 minutes of regulation time.

Syracuse led, 67-66, with 1

minute 27 seconds remaining. Penn tied the score on a free throw by Corky Calhoun a second later. When neither team could score, the game went into overtime.

The 5-foot-11-inch Bilsky, who failed to score in the first half, sent Penn ahead on a pair of free throws at 69-67 with 17 seconds gone in the overtime period. Jim Wolf and Bilsky followed with field goals to raise the Quakers' lead to 73-67.

The closest Syracuse could get after that was 4 points.

Bilsky wound up with five field goals and 11 free throws for 21 points.

Bob Morse led the Penn scoring with 14 field goals and two free throws for 30 points, while 6-11 Bill Smith topped Syracuse with 26. Wolf contributed 12 assists for Penn.

Penn will meet Utah Monday night in a semifinal game.

Trail sank six field goals and six free throws for a game-leading 18 points, and Newlin hit five baskets and five fouls for 15 points.

Utah's fast-breaking attack, which had averaged 90 points in its first seven games, was slowed by the disciplined Army defense. But the cadets' shooting was off and they lost the rebounding duel to 6-foot-5-inch Ken Gardner and Jim Mahler, 6-10.

Early in the first half, a 20-foot jump shot by Gardner gave Utah a 13-11 lead and the Utes never trailed thereafter.

Utah led by 28-22 at half-time, but Army closed the gap to 37-34 with 13 minutes 37 seconds remaining. Utah then outscored Army, 12-3, to take a 49-37 lead.

Army cut the margin to 56-50 with 2:13 to go. But Newlin hit on a jump shot and converted a foul shot for a 3-point play and John Dearman scored a field goal to clinch the game for Utah.

Dave Ralph, with 17 points and Max Miller, with 14, led the Army scoring.

Temple, led by Tim Fehrle's 24 points, defeated St. Francis of Loretto, Pa., 84-75, in the second evening game.

Fehrle scored 13 of his points in the first half as Temple built a 41-33 lead. St. Francis cut the margin at 45-43, but Temple scored 10 of the next 13 points.
