

PENN TURNS BACK HARVARD BY 81-62

Hankinson Helps Unbeaten Quakers Rally in 2d Half

CAMBRIDGE, Mass., Jan. 7
— Phil Hankinson, a sophomore, scored 18 points tonight and sparked fifth-ranked Pennsylvania to an 81-62 Ivy League basketball victory over Harvard.

Trailing by 35-29 at half-time, the unbeaten Quakers ran off 7 straight points after intermission. With the score knotted at 40-40, Penn streaked for 8 points and never trailed the rest of the way. The winners made 27 of 32 free-throw attempts including their final 14.

James Brown sparked Harvard to a first-half advantage with a 16-point, 10-rebound effort. Brown was the game's leading scorer with 24 points.

Penn has won 10 games, including two Ivy games, running its two-year Ivy victory streak to 16. Harvard is 5-8 on the season and 1-1 in league play.
