

LA SALLE UPSETS WEST. KENTUCKY

**Wins, 91-76, at Palestra—
Penn Trounces Manhattan**

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 16 (UPI)—Ken Durrett scored 45 points to lead La Salle to a 91-76 upset over fifth-ranked Western Kentucky tonight in the Palestra.

Fourth-ranked Penn defeated Manhattan, 91-68, in the second game of the double-header.

Behind an aggressive defense, La Salle overwhelmed the Hilltoppers with a series of fast-break baskets that gave the Explorers, a 28-8 lead in the first 8 minutes 10 seconds.

The Explorers led, 50-31, at half-time and coasted in the second half, with Durrett and Bobby Fields, who scored 20 points, supplying the offense.

Jim McDaniels, the 7-foot center, led the Hilltoppers with 28 points but was plagued with foul trouble most of the second half.

Durrett scored 21 points before half-time as La Salle shot at a blistering pace of 61.1 per cent in the first 20 minutes.

The victory was La Salle's 10th against one defeat and left Western Kentucky with a 12-2 record.
