

# PENN TROUNCES CORNELL, 79 TO 46

Posts 17th Victory in Row  
—Fordham Wins, 68-53

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 5 (UPI)

—Fourth-ranked Pennsylvania registered its 17th straight victory tonight by trouncing Cornell, 79-46, in an Ivy League game at the Palestra.

Sparked by the all-round play of Charlie Yelverton and the outside shooting of Bill Mainor, Fordham defeated PMC 68-53, in the second game of a double-header.

Fordham rolled to a 37-20 lead at the half and raised the margin to 21 points early in the second half.

Phil Hankinson and John Koller left the bench to spark the Quakers, who reeled off 17 straight points in the first half to turn the game into a runaway.
