

PENN WINS 25TH, ROUTING CORNELL

Quakers Take Quick Lead and Post 108-64 Victory

ITHACA, N.Y., March 5—
 Pennsylvania raced to a 23-8
 lead in the opening 10 minutes
 and then coasted to a 108-64
 victory over Cornell tonight in
 an Ivy League game.

Penn, ranked fourth in the
 nation, used superior playmak-
 ing and shooting, and an occa-
 sional full-court press to crush
 the Big Red, which has man-
 aged only five triumphs this
 season.

The unbeaten Quakers, in
 winning their 25th game, sank
 39 of 82 shots. Cornell hit on
 17 of 52 and committed 23
 turnovers.

Bob Morse and Dave Wohl
 tallied 15 points each for Penn.
