Penn Triumphs, 88-79

LOUISVILLE, Ky., Dec. 23 (AP)—Bob Morse scored 30 points and passed the 1,000-point career scoring mark as Pennsylvania defeated Western Kentucky, 88-79, tonight.

Penn led, 67-50, midway through the second half, but Western Kentucky cut the margin to 71-62 with 7:20 remaining. The Hilltoppers then missed several scoring opportunities because of Penn's full-court press and didn't get closer than 7 points.
