

PENN TROUNCES DARTMOUTH FIVE

92-62 Victory Is 8th for
 Quakers in 9 Games

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 7 (UPI)

—Alan Cotler scored 18 points and Bob Morse 17 tonight to lead Pennsylvania to its 29th consecutive Ivy League basketball victory, a 92-62 rout of Dartmouth.

The Quakers, defending Ivy League champions, rolled to their eighth victory against only one loss by opening a 46-29 half-time lead and fighting off a Dartmouth rally midway in the second half.

Dartmouth's James Brown led both teams in scoring with 23 points.
