

PENN SETS BACK VILLANOVA, 74-64

Wildcats Get One Field Goal in Almost 10 Minutes

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 19 — Phil Hankinson and Corky Calhoun combined for 44 points tonight to lead Pennsylvania to a 74-64 victory over Villanova before 9,223 in the Palestra.

Hankinson, a junior from Great Neck, L. I., scored 24 points, 17 coming in the second half.

Calhoun made nine of 13 shots as Penn converted 33 of 62 field-goal attempts.

The Quakers, who led by 32-29 at the half, dominated Villanova in the final 20 minutes.

Villanova was in trouble after 2½ minutes of the second half when Hank Siemontkowski, its leading rebounder, committed his fourth personal foul. From that point the Quakers were able to penetrate Villanova's defense, with Hankinson scoring on tapins and lay-ups.

Penn's largest margin was 68-48 with 4 minutes 21 seconds to go.

In the first half Villanova had built an early 25-16 lead. The Wildcats were then limited to one field goal in the last 9:44 of the half as Penn spurred to a 3-point advantage.

The victory left Penn one triumph short of becoming the fifth school in college basketball history to win 1,000 games.
