

PENN FIVE POSTS

1,000TH VICTORY

Becomes 5th Major College
to Reach Milestone After
Beating La Salle, 80-66

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 26 (AP) —Penn became the fifth major college to win 1,000 basketball games tonight as the ninth-ranked Quakers whipped La Salle, 80-66, at the Palestra.

In the first game, Mike Bantom powered a pair of second-half surges as St. Joseph's defeated Xavier, 75-63.

Penn, with an 11-2 won-lost record, joined Kentucky, Kansas, Oregon State and St. John's in the 1,000 club.
