

PENN'S QUINTET IS 86-66 VICTOR

Quakers Rout Dartmouth, Keep Tie for Ivy Lead

HANOVER, N. H., Feb. 5 (AP) —Phil Hankinson scored 33 points to lead Pennsylvania to an 86-66 Ivy League basketball victory over Dartmouth tonight.

The 6-foot-8-inch junior was accurate with jump shots, connecting on 14 of 21 from the floor. It was the Quakers' 14th victory in 16 games.

The victory left Penn tied for the Ivy League lead with Brown, which defeated Columbia, 78-72. Both teams have 5-1 won-lost league records.

Dartmouth, 8-8 over all, is 3-3 in the Ivy League.

Paul Erland had 20 points, Bill Raynor 17 for Dartmouth.
