

PENN BEATS YALE FOR 9TH STRAIGHT

71-62 Decision Also Raises
League Home Streak to 25

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 19 (AP) — Fifth-ranked Pennsylvania overcame a 4-point deficit early in the second half and went on to beat Yale, 71-62, in an Ivy League game tonight in the Palestra.

Penn's ninth straight victory was also its 25th consecutive league triumph at home over a three-year period. The Quakers' won-lost record is now 18-2 and 9-1 in the Ivy League.

Penn built a 21-10 lead in the first 11 minutes but Yale (7-13) battled back and forged a 33-33 tie when Mike Baskauskas made a free throw at the close of the half.

In the second game Temple defeated St. Joseph's, 60-58.
