

PENN OVERPOWERS CORNELL, 111 TO 82

Morse Shows Way as Ivy
 Leaders Shoot 65.6%

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 25 (AP)
 —Penn shot 65.6 per cent from
 the field tonight in a 111-82
 rout of Cornell in an Ivy League
 game at the Palestra.

Penn tightened its hold on
 first place in the league race.

The Quakers, fourth-ranked
 nationally, now have an over-
 all 19-2 won-lost record. They
 streaked to a 56-31 half-time
 lead by making 22 of 33 shots.
 Bob Morse led the way with 20
 points in the first half.
