COLUMBIA BEATEN BY YALE, 76-64

Victors End 5-Game Losing Streak as Kearns Stars

NEW HAVEN, Jan. 5—Yale's basketball team ended a five-game losing streak tonight, defeating Columbia, 76-64, despite 27 points by the Lions' Bob Evans.

Tim Kearns led the Elis to their third victory in 12 games by scoring 19 points. Scott Ferguson and Gary Franks chipped in with 14 apiece as Yale boosted its Ivy League won-lost record to 2-1. It was the first Ivy game of the season for Columbia, which is 2-7 over all.

Columbia led early in the game and was ahead, 21-18, when Yale rallied. Mike Baskauskas scored one basket and Ferguson added a basket and two free throws to raise the Elis lead to 24-21. They never trailed again.

Brown Routs Cornell

PROVIDENCE, R.I., Jan. 5 (AP)—Brown, led by Jay Regan, Lloyd Desvigne and Rich Cureton, scored 60 points in the second half tonight in routing Cornell, 102-79, an Ivy League game. The Bruins led, 42-36, at the half and 45-40 before going on a 10-point surge. Regan and Desvigne scored 20 points each as Brown improved its record to 5-6, including 2-1 in the league.

Marquette Wins By 1

MILWAUKEE, Jan. 5 (AP)—Larry McNeill's driving layup with nine seconds left rallied unbeaten Marquette to a 60-59 victory over stubborn De Paul tonight. It was the Warriors' 80th consecutive triumph at the Milwaukee Arena. McNeill's winning basket gave the Warriors their 10th victory this season and fourth cliff-hanger in their last five games.
