

# PENN FIVE UPSET BY BROWN, 53-51

## Basket by Morris With Two Seconds Left Breaks Tie

PROVIDENCE, Feb. 23 —

Eddie Morris hit a 15-foot jump shot with two seconds left to give Brown a 53-51 upset victory tonight over Penn, the defending Ivy League basketball champion.

Morris, a sophomore guard from Brooklyn, earlier had scored four straight free throws to give the Bruins a 51-47 lead with 1:39 remaining. But the Quakers came back to tie on a jump shot by Whitey Varga and a basket off a rebound by John Beecroft with 29 seconds left.

After killing some time, Brown called time out with 11 seconds left. Morris took the inbounds pass, dribbled to kill more time and hit the winning basket.

Both teams played erratically in the first half. After falling behind, 12-4, Brown outscored Penn, 12-2.

Brown took a 40-32 lead with 13:16 left. But Penn's guards started to work the ball to Ron Haigler, the 6-foot-8-inch forward, and the Quakers ran 8 straight points to tie, 45-45.

Brown has now won 10 and lost 11 over all and 7-4 in the league. Penn dropped to 17-5 and 9-2.

## Columbia Routs Harvard

CAMBRIDGE, Mass., Feb. 23 —Bob Evans had 32 points and Berryl Downing 24 as Columbia trounced Harvard, 86-68, in an Ivy League game tonight. Evans had 6 points in a 25-second span as the Lions outscored the Crimson, 17-2, on the way to a 35-17 advantage.

The triumph gave Columbia a 4-7 league record and a 6-16 over-all mark. Harvard dropped to 6-5 and 13-10.

## Cornell Defeated Again

HANOVER, N. H., Feb. 23 (AP)—James Brown totaled 32 points, 23 in the first half, as Dartmouth scored an 82-74 victory over Cornell tonight. It was the Big Red's 11th consecutive Ivy League defeat.

Brown's shooting sparked Dartmouth to a 39-32 half-time lead, but Cornell came back and twice took 1-point leads. But Robert Derry helped the Big Green pull away.
