

Lafayette Tops Penn by 16 to 14

EASTON, Pa., Sept. 29 — Lafayette rallied for a 16-14 victory over the University of Pennsylvania today as Gene Thaw kicked his third field goal of the day with 49 seconds left.

Tom Kubler snuffed out the Quakers' last-moment threat with an interception. It was the Leopards' second victory over Penn in 50 years.
