

# Dartmouth Bows, 82-68, At Princeton

PRINCETON, N. J., Jan. 10—Mickey Steuerer, a junior guard, scored a career high of 24 points tonight to lead Princeton to an 82-68 basketball victory over Dartmouth at Jadwyn Gymnasium.

Steuerer got 14 points in the first half as the Tigers shot 46 per cent from the floor and took a 40-34 half-time lead.

Bill Healey, a junior forward, scored 19 points to lead the Big Green. The triumph raised Princeton's over-all won-lost record to 6-5 and 2-0 in the Ivy League. Dartmouth fell to 2-7 over all and 0-2 in the league.

## Brown Beats Columbia

PROVIDENCE, R.I., Jan. 10—Brown survived a second-half rally by Columbia tonight and won its second Ivy League game without a loss, 79-73, at Marvel Gymnasium.

The favored Bruins rolled to a 37-27 lead with four minutes left in the first half. The Lions battled back to within 6 points at intermission.

Columbia rallied for a 58-51 lead with a little more than 11 minutes remaining in the game. The Bruins then went to an all-court press and with the scoring of Lloyd Desvigne gained a 61-61 tie with 7:41 to play.

The Bruins finally took the lead at 71-69 on Eddie Morris's two free throws with 1:55 left. Brian Saunders led the winners with 22 points. Mark Hardaway led the losers with 26.

## Penn Routs Harvard

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 10 (UPI)—John Engles paced a balanced scoring attack with 22 points tonight as Penn rolled to a 103-75 victory over Harvard.

Ron Haigler and Mark Lonetto added 21 points each as Penn evened its Ivy League record at 1-1 and raised its over-all mark to 8-3. Harvard is 1-1 and 3-7.

## Cornell Edges Yale, 72-70
