Columbia Beaten by Yale, 78-69

NEW HAVEN, Jan. 11—Jim McGuire, a junior from Brooklyn, scored 25 points tonight as Yale beat Columbia, 78-69, in an Ivy League contest. The victory was Yale's first in 10 games this season.

Rollin Chippey, the Elis' center, scored 17 points and grabbed 16 rebounds for Yale. Mike Haley and Cornett Lewers scored 18 points apiece for the Lions, who now have a 1-10 won-lost mark.

The Elis led by as many as 15 points in the first half, but Columbia, now 0-2 in Ivy play, trailed, 36-30, at the half. The Lions pulled within 3 points in the second half before Yale, now 1-2 in the Ivy, pulled away.
