

Cornell Loses

8th, 27-21

PHILADELPHIA, Nov. 22 (AP)—Bob Graustein rushed for three touchdowns and passed for another to lead Penn over Cornell, 27-21, in an Ivy League game today.

Graustein, a junior quarterback, was Penn's biggest offensive star, passing for 243 yards, rushing for 53 yards and scoring the winning touchdown with 8 minutes left.

Cornell's reserve quarterback, Jay La Rochelle, entered the game at the end of the third period, and ran and passed Cornell to a 21-20 lead with 9 minutes left in the game.

But after Cornell took the lead on LaRochelle's 14-yard pass to Neal Hall, Penn came back with a 69-yard touchdown drive, capped by Graustein's 13-yard scoring run.

Cornell made one last attempt, driving to Penn's 43-yard line with 2 minutes left. But two Penn defensive linemen, Bill Petuskey and Randy Bentley, sacked LaRochelle twice.

(AP)—Syracuse upset bowl-bound West Virginia 20-19 today when Dave Preston stopped a 2-point conversion attempt by the Mountaineers' Ron Lee with 17 seconds left in the game.

Down 17-0 at the half, West Virginia battled back to 20-19 when Lee scored his second touchdown of the fourth quarter with 17 seconds remaining. But his running attempt for what would have been the winning conversion was stopped short.
