

Tennessee Downs Pennsylvania, 77-70

NEW ORLEANS, Dec. 28 (AP) — Ernie Grunfeld sank a two free throws with two minutes to play that gave Tennessee a 71-69 lead, and

the Volunteers then used more free throws to clinch a 77-70 victory over Pennsylvania in the Sugar Bowl basketball tournament today.

Tulane routed Ohio State, 80-65, in the second game and will meet Tennessee in the final tomorrow night.

Following Grunfeld's scores, Johnny Darden, a 5-foot-10-inch guard, put on a dribbling show, and Pennsylvania was forced to foul as it attempted to get the ball back.

Grunfeld scored 36 points and Pennsylvania's Keven McDonald 35, including 27 in the first half when Penn took a 43-41 half-time lead in the tournament's opening game.
