
Penn 59, Cornell 41

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 12 (AP)—Tim Smith led the University of Pennsylvania on an 18-2 second-half spurt tonight en route to a 59-41 victory over Cornell at the Palestra.

Tom Crowley's two free throws with 13:17 left in the second period broke a 35-35 tie, and the Quakers then scored 16 points while Cornell could add only a layup by Stan Brown. Bob Willis's two foul shots with 5:18 remaining gave Penn a 53-37 bulge.

Smith scored 6 points in the spurt and was the Quakers' leading scorer, with 13 points. Tony Price added 12 points for Penn and grabbed a career-high total of 23 rebounds.

Brown had 17 points to pace Cornell.

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
