

McDonald Helps Penn Beat Yale

NEW HAVEN, Feb. 10 (AP)—Kevin McDonald scored 36 points, his career high, and Tony Price scored 22 tonight as Penn, the Ivy League leader, defeated Yale, 96-78.

McDonald connected on 17 of 22 shots and two of four free throws in pacing Penn to its 14th victory in 18 games over all. The Quakers are 7-0 in league play.

Joe Jolson scored 22 points for Yale and Frank Maturo chipped in 18, but the Elis lost their fifth game in a row. They are 6-10 for the season and 1-5 in league play.
