

Penn Beats Brown, 91-75, To Keep Ivy League Lead

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 24 (AP)—
Keven McDonald scored 21 points to-
night to lead the University of Pennsyl-
vania to a 91-75 triumph over Brown.

The victory gave Penn a 10-1 won-
lost record in the Ivy League and kept
the Quakers one game in front of
Columbia in the race for the league
title. Both Penn and Columbia have
three games left to play.

The Quakers held a 53-34 lead at
halftime. Stan Greene's jump shot with
12 minutes 17 seconds remaining in
the game gave the Quakers their big-
gest lead of the second half, 74-51.
Tony Price added 20 points and 13 re-
bounds for Penn while David King had
18 points for Brown, now 3-19 over
all and 1-10 in Ivy play.
