

**Penn 59, Temple 46**

**Georgetown 62, St. Joseph's 53**

**PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 8 (AP) — James Salters tossed in a career-high 25 points in leading Penn to a 59-46 victory over its Big Five rival, Temple, in the second game of a college basketball doubleheader at the Palestra tonight.**

**In the first game, Georgetown defeated St. Joseph's, 62-53 as Craig Shelton helped thwart a Hawks' rally.**

**Penn, 4-4, trailed only once at 12-11, and led 23-13 on a jump shot by Ted Flick with 6:57 left in the half. The Owls then scored 6 straight points, but the Quakers moved out to a 29-21 edge at intermission.**

**Penn outscored Temple, 12-4, at the start of the second half, and the Owls (6-5) never again got closer than 12 points.**

**In the first game, St. Joe's, 6-5, trailing by 32-18 at halftime, rallied behind the shooting of Mike Morrow, and closed to within 45-40 on a jump shot by John Smith with 8:30 left in the game. But Georgetown, 10-3, took a 52-41 advantage on a drive by Eric Smith with 4:46 remaining.**
